How Can You Tell If A Golf Ball Is Old?



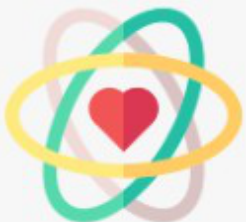
Age can be determined by examining the wear on the cover and dimples. An old golf ball will have less visible dimples and may have a lighter color than newer balls.
